

# UCP of New York City has launched a NEW In-Home Respite Program

UCP/NYC's In-Home Respite Program offers caregivers relief from the responsibility of caring for a family member with a developmental disability.

UCP/NYC respite workers provide supervision and companionship to individuals with developmental disabilities in their homes. This break gives a caregiver an opportunity to rest, reenergize, run errands, or do whatever they choose during the respite session.



Eligibility for the program requires that the person be:

- Enrolled in the Office of Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities' Home and Community Based Services **Waiver** (HCBS)
- Have a **Medicaid Service Coordinator**
- **Live at home** with their family in Manhattan, Brooklyn, Staten Island, or the Bronx.
